Just as we thought things were getting back to normal, Covid-19 cases are starting to rise around the U.S. Over the past two weeks, new infections have risen 148% and hospitalizations are up 73% per the *New York Times*. The Delta variant is to blame. The strain is said to spread as easily as chickenpox, and according to new CDC research, the fully vaccinated may also be able to spread it. Just this past week all but 23 Kentucky counties moved into the "high" or "substantial" risk for the spread of Covid-19. Henry County and Trimble County are both at high risk.

At our last meeting, the Board had decided to start having our 4th Sunday luncheons once again. Unfortunately, in light of the current situation, we feel it is in our best interest to wait a little longer. The safety of our congregation is of utmost importance.
